GOODTIME CHINESE SCHOOL

Goodtime Chinese School, established in September 2009, in Portland Oregon, has a staff with teaching experience in Chinese-English bilingual education, math, science, social study, art, etc. Goodtime has a strong teaching team that is dedicated and responsible for their work, as well as a well-equipped facility. Goodtime Chinese School has achieved greatly in Chinese-English bilingual education and has had positive evaluations from parents and the surrounding community. To satisfy the local growth of Chinese-English bilingual education, the Admission Guide (2020-2021) for Chinese-English Bilingual Preschool and Elementary School (K-3) is issued below.

Our goal is to be a K-5 elementary school and to do so we will be implementing a new grade level yearly until this is achieved. When we have 5th Grade in 2022-2023 school year. Every April, before graduation, 5th Grade students will participate in a two-week trip to China. During the trip, their Mandarin learning experience culminates in a homestay with a host family, a few days in a school in Beijing, and some sightseeing in Beijing, Xi'an, and other cities. Objectives include the students using Mandarin, experiencing the culture of China, and traveling with friends as a conclusion to their years here at Goodtime Chinese School.

TEACHING FEATURES AND SCHOOL LIFE

1. Chinese: Immersion teaching. Emphasis Chinese characters learning, reading, recitation and Chinese calligraphy. The main textbook is Yuwen, published by Renmin Education Press, Mainland, China.
2. English: Immersion teaching. Emphasizing in reading and writing comprehension, various textbooks are carefully selected for each student's level.
3. Math: Goodtime creates Chinese-English math teaching mode. Native Chinese speaking teachers teach Math with a textbook published by Renmin Education Press, Mainland, China. Native English-speaking teachers teach Singapore Math, a series textbook published in Singapore. This method has been shown to have a beneficial effect through testing and feedback from parents.
4. Other courses: To have students learn in a bilingual interactive surrounding, the same topics are taught in both Chinese and English- like science, social studies, art, and PE.
5. Lunch of Chinese and American food are served to satisfy student health. Goodtime also organizes Chinese and American cultural activities, so the students can enjoy diverse cultures.
